PROVISION FOR SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION FORM FOR ADMISSION TO VARIOUS COURSES AFTER THE LAST DATE WITH LATE FEE

The Application Forms for all courses are submitted by the prospective candidates only in ONLINE Mode on or before the notified last date of submission.

Last year, the proposal of giving a limited time for submission of Admission Forms after the notified last date was approved and one week time was given for submission of Admission Forms after the last date with provision of additional payment of Late Fee of Rs. 300/-. If approved, the same practice be continued for the session 2021-2022.

To consider the proposal to allow sponsorship for all courses being offered by the University to Children of NRIs, at par MBBS / BDS courses being offered by MCC.

As per directions / orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case (W.P.) (C) No. 689/2017-Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs. Union of India & Ors.) dated 22.08.2017, the following can sponsor a candidate for admission to MBBS & BDS courses under NRI Category, being offered by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC):

- (a) He should be the nearest relation.
- (b) In the definition of the nearest relation, committee has considered following relative having blood relations.
 - (i) Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.
 - (ii) Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - (iii) Father and mother of father i.e. grand father and grand mother.
 - (iv) Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grand father and maternal grand mother.
 - (v) First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.
 - (vi) Such person should be NRI

The University offers admissions to various courses under NRI category to the Children of NRIs only. As per Guide to Admissions (Supplement-FN), 2020-2021, the following is the definition of Non-Resident Indians (NRIs):

"A Non Resident Indian (NRI) is an Indian citizen resident outside India for purposes of employment, carrying on business or vocation in circumstances as would indicate an intention to stay outside India for an indefinite period. An individual will also be considered NRI if his stay in India is less than 182 days during the preceding financial year. He/she must be eligible to open and should have an operative NRE Bank Account."

To consider the proposal to revise the Minimum Qualification for admission to M.Sc. (Mathematics) Course.

1. The Board of Studies of the Department of Mathematics held on 10.10.2018, under Item No. 01, decided to relax the following eligibility criteria for admission to M.Sc. (Mathematics) which was duly approved in the Ordinary meeting of Faculty of Science held on 21.12.2019, under any other Item (d):

“B. Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics / B. Sc. With Mathematics as one of the subjects studied in all three years with not less than 55% marks in aggregate and not less than 60% marks in Mathematics with any two of the subjects Physics / Computer Science / Chemistry / Statistics as the subsidiary”

2. It is pointed out that, the above minutes of the Ordinary meeting of the Faculty held on 21.12.2019, circulated vide D. No. 1665/FSC dated 04.01.2020 by the Dean, Faculty of Science was later sent by the Chairman to the Vice-Chancellor on 22.10.2020 whereas the Admission Committee for the session 2020-2021 had already taken place on 19.12.2019.

3. The Vice-Chancellor appended following remarks on the note sheet (Flag “A”) prepared in response to the letter of the Chairman, Dept. of Mathematics D.No. 7288/Maths. Dated 22.10.2020:

“We will consider for next year 2021-2022 session”

The Vice-Chancellor on the letter of the Chairman, Dept. of Law D. No. 3584/Law dated 15.12.2020 has ordered that the matter regarding conduct of Admission Test for LL.M. course will be put up before the meeting of the Admission Committee.

The Chairman, Department of Law has stated the following:

1. Law Department of AMU is a prestigious Department and carrying a reputation not only in India but also at International Level. The courses carried out in the Department of Law like BALLB (Hons.), LLM and Ph.D. is in great demand nationwide due to the reputation of its quality and high standard.
2. BALLB Entrance Test is conducted centrally by the Controller of Examinations. Earlier the Entrance Test of LLM was also conducted centrally to maintain sanctity of the test and fairness of the admission.
3. For reasons best known to the University the LLM Test has been shifted from Central Level to the Department Level, probably during the period of the previous Vice-Chancellor. The Department of Law is conducting LLM Test successfully in spite of having limited resources at its disposal. The entire procedure of conducting the test involves different stages like submission of application forms, setting of question paper, printing of question paper, arrangement of Test Centres, issuance of Hall Tickets etc. In the present context I feel that department of Law is not properly equipped for the same and therefore help of the Controller of Examinations is frequently required at every stage.

In the light of the above facts, the Chairman has requested the Admission Test again may be conducted at Central Level as the office of the Controller of Examinations is much more equipped in term of technology and resources for the smooth conduct of the test.

It is pointed out that the proposal for conducting Departmental Test from the session 2017-2018 of LL.M. was placed in the Admission Committee in its meeting held on 13.12.2016 and agreed and recommended to the Academic Council. The Admission Tests of the courses for which not more than 500 Application Forms were received in the last 02 previous sessions may be conducted at the Departmental level. Candidates selected for admission to B.A. (Hons.) Course shall be allocated only the Main Subject based on their performance in the Admission Test. Subsidiary subjects shall be allotted at the time of admission, subject to the options available.

It is pointed out that the Faculty meeting has not been convened, therefore, the approval of the Vice-Chancellor has been obtained on behalf of the Faculty / Admission Committee
